A new range of templates now available at S&S. This large range of templates can be used in a variety of ways for colouring fabric. Fabric Stenciling is a fantastic way to begin playing with fabric manipulation. Easy to use with a variety of mediums, for great results

Place stencil over fabric and with the use of a stencil brush, sponge brush or piece of sponge, apply fabric colour onto the exposed fabric.

To hold stencil in place, spray lightly with spray adhesive.

For best results, dampen sponge and pick up a small amount of Colourcraft fabric colour and apply to fabric.

Once dry iron to heat set.

Leave 24 hours before washing.

Other suitable products to use with the templates are discharge paste, fabric markers, Derwent Inktense pencils with Textile medium, Shiva Oil Paintstiks and Playcolor Textil Sticks.

Templates are also suitable to use in sun printing and gelli plate printing. When your fabric is coloured, you can then embellish and manipulate the fabric with hand embroidery, machine stitching, shrinking, quilting and patchwork.
