This rugged paper looks and feels like leather, but sews, cuts and washes just like fabric. Use it to bring an exciting new texture to your craft – sewing projects.

Ideal for making bags, wallets, journal covers and furnishings.

It can be sewn, stamped, painted, embossed, ironed and dyed.

Available in natural, black and white

These handy pouches were created from white kraft tex.

- 1. Dampen Kraftex with water and emboss with cardboard lettering by rolling it through a press.
- 2. Using a Pigma Micron pen zentangle a design onto areas or colour with FW inks
- 3. Stitch up to create a pouch.





Stencilling onto Kraftex using Crafters Workshop stencils and inks, is another way of colouring this medium. Once dry iron on Transfer Artist Paper and create layers.
