

# Gelli Plate Printing

## ***Ways to Monoprint***

- Remove clear film from plate
- Roll Marabu fabric paint onto gel surface with a brayer.
- Create designs by pressing textured objects into colour or placing objects onto plate. For example, Cedar canyon rubbing plates , skeleton leaves, string, stencils. paper shapes, bubble wrap, jean pockets, stencils.
- Lay fabric onto painted surface and gently rub over with hands to transfer colour .
- Remove fabric from printing plate to reveal print.
- Remove objects from plate and wipe plate with water and paper towel.
- Once dry, you can reprint over the fabric many times by repeating the above steps. Colourcraft fabric paint dries very quickly so this is an excellent technique to be carried out in one lesson.
- When dry, iron to set colour and it will be washable

You can further embellish your print with Marabu Fashion Liners and/or Blocks, Sharpie fabric pens, stitching, Angelina fibres etc
