Gelli Plate Image Transfer / Resist Printing

- 1. Apply a thin layer of a dark coloured acrylic paint onto your Gelli Plate using a roller and lightly cover the plate.
- 2. Lay your magazine print on top of the Gelli Plate and rub well (using either your hand or a clean roller).
- 3. Carefully and slowly remove the magazine print. If you can see that it hasn't transferred when you lift a corner, place it back down and roll again.
- 4. Allow the Gelli Plate to dry (5 minutes is ample longer is fine too).
- 5. Using a lighter coloured acrylic paint, apply it to the dried Gelli Plate with a roller in a thin layer (you should still be able to see the print through the paint).
- 6. Put your paper on top of the Gelli Plate and rub well in order to pick up the print.
- 7. Again, remove slowly.
- 8. Congratulations! You have just done an image transfer using a Gelli Plate!
