



Marabu Photo Transfer Medium



Printed motifs, photos lettering etc can be transferred to a variety of surfaces with the water-based Photo Transfer Medium. After a drying time of 2 hours or 8 minutes with a hair dryer, you can moisten and rub off the paper, leaving the transferred design.

HOW IT WORKS ON WOOD, CANVAS, FRAMES, METAL ETC.

1. APPLY

Create the photo using a laser printer. Paint the clean and dry background as well as the surface of the printout fully. Do not leave out any areas.

2. STICK

Place the printout with the printed image on the background and smooth down with a scraper or finger. Remove any excess medium straight away. Do not spread the medium over the paper applied. Leave to dry for 2 hours or dry with a hair dryer.

3. RUB

Wet the paper printout with water and soak it well. Carefully rub the paper with a finger or sponge. Repeat the procedure until all paper layers have been removed.

4. PROTECT

Paint over with Aqua matt varnish to remove paper fibre residues and protect the picture.

TIPS

- Writing must be printed back-to-front.
- For used-look images, tear out rather than cutting out.
- When applying the medium, do not paint over the stuck-on image.
